Ernesto Bosch was born in Philadelphia, USA, in 1968. He completed Medicine School in University of Valencia in 1992. Specialist in Obstetrics and Gynaecology by Hospital La Fe in Valencia from 1993 to 1997. Training in Human Reproduction in the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania in 1997; doctoral thesis with *cum laude* qualification about the influence of LH in oocyte quality in University of Valencia in 1999. Since January 2000 belongs to the Human Reproduction Unit of the Instituto Valenciano de Infertilidad in Valencia, where has participated in several clinical research projects. In 2008 he obtained the title of Master in Research on Health Sciences, by the Autonomous University of Barcelona. He has 75 publications with a total Impact Factor of 168. Dr. Bosch has given over 125 lectures in International meetings around the world. He belongs to the Editorial Board of Fertility and Sterility and Reproductive Biomedicine Online and is a regular reviewer of Human Reproduction, and Reproductive Biology and Endocrinology. He has received the Scientific Program Prize Paper Award at the 2008 Annual Meeting of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine. In 2010 he was appointed as Medical Director of the Human Reproduction Unit in the Instituto Valenciano de Infertilidad in Valencia.
