

STRATIS KOLIBIANAKIS BIOGRAPHY:



Dr Efstratios Kolibianakis is currently Senior Lecturer in Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Human Reproduction, Unit for Human Reproduction at Aristotle University, Thessaloniki, Greece.

Dr Kolibianakis received his medical degree from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and then trained in Obstetrics and Gynaecology in London, UK, before obtaining an MSc and PhD from the Dutch Speaking Brussels Free University in Belgium. Dr Kolibianakis served as a Consultant at the Centre for Reproductive Medicine, at the same university.

Dr Kolibianakis' work has included 75 publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals (PubMed 11/2007), several book chapters and more than 70 presentations at international meetings. He is a reviewer of 11 international Journals and Associate Editor of Human Reproduction. Dr Kolibianakis' fields of scientific interest include reproductive endocrinology and ovarian stimulation.
